Term: Autumn 1

Topic: The Stone Age Key Question: What was life like in the Stone Age?

English:

Books

In English, we will be linking our learning with History, through the book, Stone Age Boy. Our class author will be Dick King-Smith.

Writing

We will begin by linking our writing to our book, Stone Age Boy. We will then be writing information texts, using the correct features of the genre. We will also create our own information booklets.

Reading

In Guided Reading, we will be developing our expression and our comprehension skills.

Maths:

In Maths we will be focusing on mental and written methods for addition and subtraction and using inverses to check our answers. We will develop our skills in one and two step problem solving. We will develop our reasoning skills through investigations into number facts and place value.

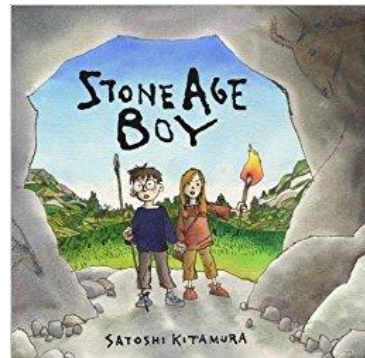
Science:
