Term: Autumn 1

Topic: World War 2 Key Question: What was life like during World War 2?



Class novel: Goodnight Mr Tom

English:

Novels and stories by a significant children's author:

As readers we will be enjoying a selection of books by children's author, David Weisner. As writers we will be creating stories to accompany his picture books and writing similar stories of our own.

Recounts:

Using the story of 'Rose Blanche', we will become more aware of what life was like for children during World War 2. We will use this to help us write recounts of 'our' experiences.

Maths:

This term, we will be looking at number and place value. This will include: reading, writing and comparing numbers up to 1000, 000 and determining the value of each digit. Following on from this, we will be interpreting negative numbers and using them in context. We will be adding and subtracting numbers with more than five digits as well as applying these skills to solving problems.

Science:

Earth and Space


We will be learning to describe the movement of the Earth and other planets, relative to the sun in the Solar System as well as describing the movement of the Moon relative to the earth.

We will be using the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

Religious Education:

The Bible:

Children will learn and retell stories from the Bible. Children will be able to reference stories from the bible correctly and refer to the stories they have heard.



History:

Children will learn about life during World War 2.

As historians we will investigate:

*How children experienced the war.

*How the war has impacted on Britain historically.

Children will use a variety of fiction and non-fiction resources to research the changes which occurred during World War 2.

Children will also learn about how the war was experienced in Liverpool and the impact it had on the city.

PSHE (SEAL):

New Beginnings:

Children will discuss our class rules and create a class charter which we will all agree upon and sign. We will set ourselves targets for the whole year.

Physical Education:

Games:

Children will use co-ordination, agility and team work skills.

Dance/Gymnastics:

Children will use movement and balance skills.

Art / Design Technology:

Underwater art inspired by David Miller.

We will be investigating the artwork of David Miller and using the David Weisner book 'Flotsam' as inspiration for our own creations.

Spanish:

In Spanish, we will learn simple introductory greetings, the Spanish alphabet and how to ask for items in a shop or restaurant.

Computing:

Coding:

We will use Espresso to carry various instructions to make objects perform different tasks. We will begin to understand how simple algorithms work.

Music:

We will be having lots of fun studying songs from gone by and focussing on rhythm, rhyme and pitch.
