Class novel: The Snowman, Raymond Briggs

English:

Books

In English, we will be linking our learning to the book, The Snowman by Raymond Briggs.

Writing

We will begin by linking our writing to our book, The Snowman. We will then write snowman, winter and Christmas themed shape poems.

Reading

In Guided Reading, we will be developing our comprehension and inference skills.

Maths:

In Maths we will be focusing on mental and written methods for multiplication and division using inverses to check our answers. We will be learning about fractions, including finding fractions of sets of objects and whole numbers. We will develop our skills in one and two step problem solving. We will develop our reasoning skills through investigations.

Science:

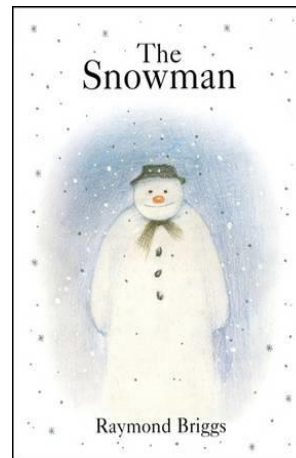
As Scientists, we will be learning about nutrition. We will learn that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they get nutrition from what they eat.

We will plan, prepare and eat our own healthy sandwich!

Religious Education:

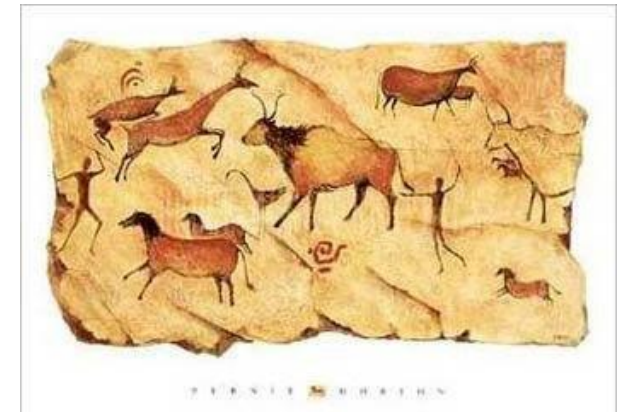
In R.E. we will be exploring the theme of Light.

We will learn about how light is an important symbol for Christians and the significance of light at Christmas. We will make our own Christingle!



History:

During our History lessons we continue to explore how people lived in Ancient times. We will explore chronological order and place events on a timeline.



PSHE (SEAL):

We will be exploring nutrition and healthy eating and hygiene during our Science lessons.

We will explore what positively and negatively affects children's physical, mental and emotional health.

Physical Education:

Play invasion games and apply basic principles of attacking and defending in a variety of games.

Perform dances using a variety of movement patterns.

Art / Design Technology:

In Art we will be creating pieces of Christmas art using a variety of media.

In Design Technology we will design and make a healthy sandwich.

Spanish:

In Spanish we will learn the alphabet, numbers to 31 and the months of the year.

We will use our learning in sentences, for example to say when our birthdays are.

Computing:

In Computing we will develop our basic skills using Microsoft Word to create calendar templates.

We will also programme a Fuzz in Kodable. This will involve creating and amending algorithms.
