Term: Summer 1



Key texts:

English:

This half term we will be exploring traditional tales. We will be reading lots of traditional tale stories such as The Three Little Pigs, Jack and the Beanstalk, Cinderella and many more. We will look at the patterns within each story and the features which make this story type special. We will learn about the characters, settings and the events which take place. We will look closely at different versions of traditional tales and see how they have developed over time. We will also explore our own story telling and will write our own stories in a similar style to those we will be studying.

Maths:

This half term we will continue to learn all about fractions. We will focus on halves and quarters and will be exploring these fractions within a range of shapes and quantities. We will also be focusing on measurement over the coming weeks and will be learning about length, weight and capacity. We will explore these topics using both non-standard units and the appropriate standard units such as centimetres, metres, grams, kilograms, millilitres and litres.

Science:

This half term we will be exploring the topic 'Animals including humans'. We will be learning about the different parts of our body and will be labelling them and thinking about why they are important. We will also be learning about our senses and will match each sense to the matching part of our bodies. We will investigate our senses further and will complete experiments using them. We will explore the groups of animals in the world including mammals, reptiles, amphibians etc. We will learn about how animals can be classified into different groups using different criteria and we will learn about what animals eat.

Religious Education:

We will be exploring the question 'What is a Saint?'. During this topic we will identify the meaning of 'a follower' and 'a leader' and will look closely at the followers of Jesus. We will consider what made Jesus a good leader and will delve deeper into the lives of his followers including St Margaret and St George as well as recent followers such as Mother Teresa.

Physical Education:

This half term we will be exploring team work games such as matball and football. We will explore what it means to work as a team and will learn more about the skills needs to work together such as passing. We will be developing our team skills in taking part in relay activities. We will also be learning how to follow the rules of games.

Art / Design Technology:

Design and make 3d models of castles collaboratively in a group.

Observational drawings focusing on sketching skills. This will be linked to the changing seasons.

History:

Our topic this half term is Castles. We will be learning all about the parts of a castle and the use for each part in keeping castles safe from danger. We will also explore the lives of people inside the castle from the King and Queen to their squires, handmaids and the peasants.

Computing:

We will be learning to use a range of programming skills using Spheros and Beebots.

Spanish:

We will be learning about colours and days of the week.

PSHE (SEAL):

Our Jigsaw topic is 'Relationships'. In our PSHE lessons, we will be thinking about people who are special to us and identify reasons why they are special.

Music:

'Your Imagination'

During this topic we will be explore a range of songs and music and compare and contrast these pieces. Children will compose their own songs.
