Term: Summer 1

English:

In English this half term, we will continue to place a significant focus on handwriting and spelling. In preparation for SATs, we will be revising the application of Grammar, Spelling and Punctuation in our own our writing and a variety of texts. In addition to this, we will continue to develop our reading comprehension by identifying inference and discussing authorial intent whilst analysing texts.

Following workshops with visiting poet, Andy Tooze, we will appreciate, appraise and perform poems. Using this as our inspiration, we will be using poetic devices to write and perform our own poems.

Maths:

During Maths lessons this half term, we will be revising our arithmetic skills across the Key Stage 2 curriculum and applying these to solve reasoning problems. This will include:

- Number (+ - \times \div and fractions, decimals and percentages);
- Ratio and Algebra;
- Geometry, Measures and Statistics.

Science:

Living Things and their Habitats:

As Scientists, we will be able to:

- Describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals.
- Give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics.

Religious Education:

In R.E. this half term we will be discussing the key Christian concepts of Gospel, Salvation and Kingdom of God through the topic of Ascension and Pentecost. In order to answer the question 'In what ways do these events and beliefs make Christianity distinctive?' we will focus on the key skills of apply, interpret and express to:

- Explore the book of Acts in the Bible.
- Recount significant events.
- Discover the impact of these events on Christian beliefs.
- Make connections to the sacraments of the church.
- Explore briefly the lives of Christians today who have been inspired by the Holy Spirit.

PSHE (SEAL):

Our Jigsaw puzzle is 'Relationships'. In our PSHE lessons, we will be learning how to recognise when people are trying to gain power or control. We will also identify ways of standing up for ourselves and our friends.

Physical Education:

This half term we will be exploring team work games such as football and Lacrosse. We will explore what it means to work as a team and will learn more about the skills needed such as gaining possession and adapting techniques during a game. We will learn to apply skills, techniques and ideas consistently. We will be developing our team skills in taking part in relay activities developing our use of stamina in long activities. We will also develop how to throw accurately and combining running and jumping confidently.
