How are you getting on with our working memory challenges?

Your auditory memory (remembering things that you hear) challenge this week is Can you....?

Can you...?

- Ask a grown up to help you with this activity.
- Your grown up will ask you to complete the following directions.

One part

- Clap your hands
- Touch your nose
- Hop
- Turn around
- Sit down

Two part

- Touch your foot then sit down
- Stand up then turn around
- Wave your hands then touch the ground
- Shake your head then touch your nose
- Touch your knee then your elbow

Three part

- Rub your arm, hop then close your eyes
- Point to the door, the chair then the table
- Stand up, point to your ear then rub your tummy
- Clap your hands, stamp your feet and touch your eyebrow

Four part

- Clap your hands, click your fingers, point to the ceiling and show your teeth
- Nod your head, point to your wrist, blink your eyes and stand up
- Stand up, sit down, turn around and jump
- Open your mouth, put your hand in the air, point to your nose and hop

Your next challenge is to build up your visual memory (remembering things that you see).

Indoor Scavenger Hunt

Try to find and collect as many items as possible

- A toy with wheels
- A book with the first letter of your name in the title
- A pair of matching socks
- 4 things that are green
- Something very soft
- A toy smaller than your hand
- Something round
- An item you can see yourself in
- Something you can squeeze
- Something precious to you

The main part of your visual memory challenge is to remember where you got all your items from and put everything back in exactly the same place!
