Choose one of the characters and describe them to a partner.

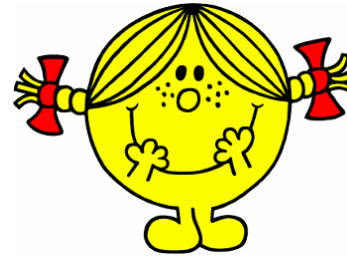
Remember not to give their name away! Can your partner find who you are describing?

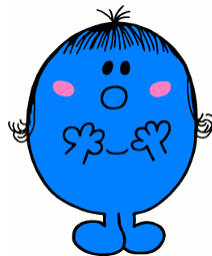

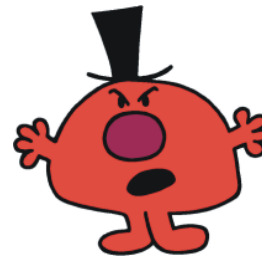

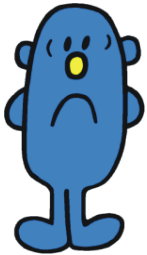
