Maths

Can you find the answer to these addition questions?

$13 + 6 = \underline{\quad}$	$19 + 9 = \underline{\quad}$

Challenge Mrs Erving has 21 strawberries. She shares them equally and each bowl gets 7 Strawberries. How many bowls did she share them between?	







- Write some sentences to tell me where your animal lives, what it eats and what animal group it belongs to




You can do this as many times as you like for as many animals as you want! Maybe you could create your own animal fact file book!


Challenge: Your computing challenge this week is to drag objects on a game to create a new image
