Party Games to play with your family

Lookout

Someone stands at the far end of the room, with their back turned to the rest of the group. The rest of the group stands at the opposite end of the room in a line. The idea is that they have to sneak up on the person. But at any point, the person on lookout can turn around. When they do, everyone has to freeze!

Anyone seen moving by the person on lookout is either 'out' or sent back to the beginning again.

Under, Over

Line up with the front child holding a ball or cushion. On 'go' you must pass the ball, alternately, backwards over your heads and between legs until it reaches the last in the line. The last person then dashes around to the front to repeat the process. This continues until the original front person is back at the beginning when the whole team sits down.



Sleeping Lions

Lie down and keep as still as you can. The aim of the game is to remain motionless when the adult is walking around, and perhaps telling jokes. Anyone who itches, wriggles or giggles is out. The winner is the one who stays still the longest.
