Term: Autumn 1



Key texts: *The Glugs*, *Bog Baby* and *The Sound Collector*.

### English:


Children will explore captions and labels in their environment. They will spend time creating their own characters based on the poem, 'The Glugs' and will develop their descriptive vocabulary when labelling and describing these. They will learn about stories from a familiar setting and will complete activities based on the story 'Bog Baby'. After exploring their senses, children will use 'The Sound Collector' to write a verse of a poem.

### Maths:

This term, children will become familiar and confident with number and its value. They will work within 100 to complete sequences, count forward and backwards and identify more or less than. Children will spend time working on number bond knowledge within 20.

### Science:

In Science, children will begin to investigate and observe our ongoing topic 'Seasonal Changes' to notice changes as we move from Summer to Autumn. They will use their local environment to explore and answer questions about plants and trees growing in their habitat.



### Religious Education:

Children will explore the Creation story to discover how God created the world round us. They will learn about the season of Harvest and its importance in our Church calendar.

Children will explore colour mixing and link this to the colours they observe in the environment.

### History:

Children will explore our school and local area. They will learn about keeping safe when they are out and will identify important signs they see on their travels.

### Music:
