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Key Stage 2: Average Scale Scores and Progress

Pupils' raw scores are converted into a 'scaled score'. Scaled scores range from 80-120. A scaled score outcome of 100 is deemed to be the Expected Standard for pupils taking the Key Stage 2 SATs.

Pupils who achieve a scaled score of 110+ are deemed to be working at a Greater Depth within the Expected Standard.

A school's progress score in Reading, Writing and Mathematics will be calculated by an average of pupils' individual progress scores for that subject. Progress made is based on their Key Stage 1 outcomes (Average Point Score). The progress scores indicate whether pupils within school - as a group - have made more than, less than or average progress when compared to all pupils with similar starting points.
