Term: Summer 1

Topic: Geography - Raging Rivers



English:

Film narrative: The Piano

We will watch and re-watch the film *The Piano* by Aidan Gibbons, discussing features and themes. We will explore approaches made by the film maker to create moods, pace and viewpoint and identify how colour, light, sound and camera angles have been used to tell the narrative. We will finish by writing a narrative for the film.

Legends: King Arthur

We will read and make comparisons between different versions of the same legend, describing similarities and differences. We will become familiar with the genre of Legends and identify the features that make a good Legend.

We will use what we have studied about the genre to write another version of a Legend, before writing our very own.

Maths:

This term we will be looking at Measure and the Properties of Shapes.

We will be finding the perimeter of rectilinear shapes and finding the area of rectangles in cm^2 and m^2 .

We will be identifying 3D shapes and their properties before moving on to measuring and drawing angles in degrees.

We will be working to identify, describe and represent the position of a shape following a reflection or translation, using the appropriate language, and know that the shape has not changed.

Science:

Properties and Changes of Materials.

Following on from our work in year 4 on States of Matter, we will be focussing on the properties of materials and how these are important when choosing materials for a purpose.

We will be investigating the properties of various materials and studying how these properties may change in certain conditions e.g. when heat is applied, causing reversible and irreversible changes.

Religious Education:

Women in the Old Testament.

This unit will aim to widen our knowledge and understanding of the role and significance of women in the Bible.

We will reflect upon the actions of these women and consider what we can learn from their stories.

We will study the stories of women in the Old Testament such as Ruth, Esther, Jochebed the mother of Moses, Miriam Moses' sister and Sarah (Abraham's wife and Isaac's Mother).

Geography:

Raging Rivers.

In this topic we will recap our previous work on the water cycle and see where rivers fit into this process, focussing also on the key features of rivers.

We will look specifically at the features of certain rivers and compare them, identifying what rivers are used for.

A lot of this learning will stem from our river study to be carried out this term.

Atlas and map work will feature throughout.

PSHE (SEAL):

Physical Education: This half term we will be exploring team work games such as football and Lacrosse. We will explore what it means to work as a team and will learn more about the skills needed such as gaining possession and adapting techniques during a game. We will be developing our team skills in taking part in relay activities. We will also be learning how to throw accurately and combining running and jumping.
