



## Love, Jasmine Celebration Day 31<sup>st</sup> January 2019



Jasmine was a much loved pupil here at SMA and should have been celebrating her 11<sup>th</sup> Birthday on Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> January as a Year 6 pupil with her friends. Her three younger brothers all attend our school.

Jasmine died very suddenly and unexpectedly during the school summer holidays in August 2014 whilst on a family holiday in North Wales in a tragic choking incident. Jasmine was a perfectly healthy and well little girl and despite immediate first aid Jasmine's family had to watch helplessly as her life support was switched off only a few hours later.

Jasmine was a very kind and caring little girl and was always helping others. Jasmine's parents knew that they had to do something in her memory to help others and for her name and memory to live on. The Love, Jasmine Charity was therefore established in September 2016 to offer support to bereaved families following the loss of a child and we are proud to support it. The charity provides a whole range of support services, including [one to one counselling](#) and [family group work](#) as well as holding [support groups](#) and coffee mornings for bereaved family members.
