



Parent/ Carer Forum

The Forum was established in 2015 as a supportive role to the school; pupils, parents, carers and staff. The first meeting was held in November 2015. As a committee, we report to Governors every year and agendas and minutes are published on the school website.

We are a group of parents and carers from across the school community who meet each half term on a Friday morning in the school. The agenda for each meeting is sent out before the meeting and the Headteacher is asked if there are items upon which she would like our consultation. We have been asked to view and give opinions upon various policies which school has produced, in order to be a parent/carers voice. We have welcomed visits from pupils, such as the E-Safety Cadets who came to discuss what they do in school and the importance we as a school, place on E-Safety in and out of school.

We have successfully worked with the School Council to achieve a traffic calming zone outside school. This has resulted in the Liverpool City Council Road Safety team creating a 20mph speed restriction area with signage and lights outside our school.

We offer support as helpers for organised coffee mornings and advice meetings and are greatly appreciated at various school events.
