Items to be discussed

1. Welcome – Apologies to be noted

2. Accident outside of school - Recently there was a road traffic accident outside the school in the morning. We are awaiting the Police Report into the accident. Luckily the child was not badly injured but was taken to hospital to be checked over. Whilst the school did everything possible to help and support the family and the people who saw the incident, it definitely has made us all aware of how serious it could have been. We are therefore looking into how we can improve road safety outside of SMA. A few years ago, following a campaign led by the Forum, we were able to have a 20mph zone implemented outside school with lights and signage, we are hoping with support from the Liverpool Road Safety team to have some improvement on this.

3. Parent/Carer Courses - We are responding to requests for courses and workshops.

Maths We are responding to requests to hold a Maths course for parents/carers who are wanting to support their child's learning. Miss King, as the Maths Lead in school, has been planning a session and is hoping to arrange a date shortly.

EAL We held a 6 week course to help parents/carers who are uncertain of the system in British schools and how to support their children. It was attended by a number of parents who are new to the UK and they benefitted greatly from the support and advice given.

ESOL We are in the planning stages of arranging a course to further support parents/carers for whom English is an additional language. Hopefully this will be starting after Easter.

4. Our Liverpool – We are going to be part of a project run by Phil Clarke working on Hate Crime in our area. He is based in the Tuebrook Children's Centre and we will have more information soon.

We hope to have a Buddy system in place to support pupils who may be vulnerable.

5. Any other business – Home School Agreement is being looked over and should be ready in April.
