MESSAGE FROM MR GRIFFITHS

Thank you to everyone who donated yesterday to Cash 4 Kids Day. We raised over £170. The total number of steps is still being counted but we know it is over 330,000!

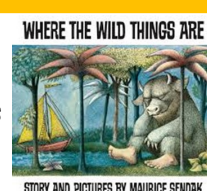

Year 1 are currently reading "Where the Wild Things Are" by Maurice Sendak. This book explores emotions and imagination.



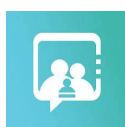
