MESSAGE FROM MR GRIFFITHS

Dear Parents and Carers,

On Tuesday, our Year 4 children had a fantastic time at the Blue Planet Aquarium - they came back full of facts and stories about the sea life they saw. Year 1 had their own adventure on Thursday with their trip to *Imagine That!*, which was full of wonder, hands-on fun and creativity. A huge thank you to the staff who helped make both trips so special.

Yesterday was also a very special moment for our Year 6 children, as they celebrated their Graduation Ceremony. It was a lovely way to mark the end of their primary school journey, and we're so proud of everything they've achieved.

This morning, our Reception children wowed us with their End of Year Assembly - there wasn't a dry eye in the hall!

Looking ahead to next week, our final one of the school year, here's what's coming up:

Monday: Nursery Graduation - times have been shared in the letters sent home this week.

Tuesday: *Whole School Fun Day!* Children will enjoy a fun-filled day of activities. Please note this is a children-only event - no parents/carers this time. Children should wear their own clothes suitable for taking part in sporting activities.

In the afternoon, our Musical Theatre Club will be having their final performance. Children involved will stay after school for their dress rehearsal at 3.15pm (a meal will also be provided). Doors open to parents/carers at 4.15pm, with the show starting promptly at 4.30pm.

Wednesday: We will be celebrating *St Margaret's Day*, our school and parish saint.

Thursday: Nursery's last day of term. Morning session ends at 11:30am and the afternoon session at 3:30pm, as usual.

Our Year 6 Leavers' Service will take place in church - all parents/carers are warmly welcome. Please be seated before 10am for a prompt start.

After school, Year 6 children will be heading back in for their end-of-year *Prom/Disco!* Children should go home at 3.15pm to get changed and return for a 4pm start. The prom/disco finishes at 5.30pm and all children must be collected by a responsible adult. If your child usually walks home and you need to discuss arrangements, please call the school office on 0151 260 5522.

Friday: *Last day of term!* We'll enjoy a movie morning and early lunch before finishing for the summer at 1.15pm prompt. Please ensure your child is collected on time.


