Dear Parents and Carers,

It's been another busy and exciting week in school, and I'd like to share a few  
updates with you.

#### **School Photo Day—individual and sibling photos**

#### **Attendance**

#### **XT Active After-School Provision**

We are pleased to let you know that **XT Active after-school provision will  
begin from Monday 13th October**. This after school provision will give  
families additional childcare options beyond the school day. There is an  
offer on for £4 per session up until Friday 24th October, thereafter it will  
go back to the £8 per session price. We will let you know when the booking  
site goes live.

- **Universal Credit** (via a dedicated tab)
- **Support for students in higher education** (help with childcare costs is available  
- more details on GOV.UK: *Help with childcare while you study*)
- **Children with PEP or EHC Plans** (eligible to access wraparound provision, and  
families may also be able to claim Tax-Free Childcare)
- **Foster parents** who work outside of their fostering role may also be eligible for  
Tax-Free Childcare.

Parents will need to register online to access support, and eligibility can be checked  
directly via the **Childcare Choices** website.

#### **World Mental Health Day**

Next Friday, we will be marking **World Mental Health Day** with a range of  
activities in school. To show support, children are invited to **wear something  
yellow** and bring a **£1 donation**, which will go towards funding our much-  
valued wellbeing activities. A letter with the details has been sent home with

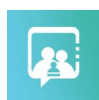
