Monday 1 st December	Raffle tickets on sale	Raffle tickets will go on sale daily from Monday 1 st December. They can be purchased for £1 a strip from the school office at the end of each day. Tickets can also be bought at the school fayre.
Wednesday 3 rd December	Christmas Disco	School disco Ticketed event - separate letter to follow. (Own clothes allowed.) The disco will take place straight from school. If children aren't attending the disco, they will finish school at the usual time. Reception and KS1 – starts straight from school and finishes at 4:40pm. Tickets £3.00 – ticket price includes the cost of tuck / snack (allergies will be catered for) KS2 – starts straight from school and finishes at 4:45pm Tickets £2.00, children can bring money to spend in the tuck shop. All children will be collected from classroom doors.

Wednesday 10 th December	Christmas Fayre	Fayre opens from 2:00pm, parents / carers can collect children from classroom doors between 1:45-2:15pm and then attend the fayre. If children aren't collected, they will visit the fayre with class teacher. Once collected, parents are responsible for their children. If parents choose to leave school before the end of day with their child, they must sign out via the school office.
